## Grand Knight's Report (cont'd)

As we welcome 2019, let's start with a reading from Acts of the Apostles to pray for **Boldness** in Acts 4.23-30. ***"After they were released, they went to their friends and reported what the chief priests and the elders has said to them. When they heard it, they raised their voices together to God and said Sovereign Lord who made the heaven and earth, the sea and everything in them, it is you who said by the Holy Spirit, through our ancestor David your servant 'Why did the gentiles rage and the peoples imagine vain things?' The Kings of the earth took their stand and the rulers gathered together against the Lord and against His Messiah". For in this city, in fact, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the gentiles and the people of Israel, gathered together against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed, to do whatever your hand and plan had predestined to take place. Only when we live this faith, that we can evangelize without saying a word, and as Jesus said, **"you will know who my brothers and sisters are when they follow my words"**.

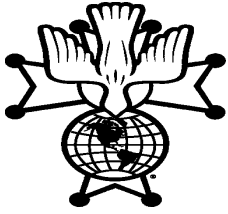
