



A note read by Deputy Grand Knight Dan Wolocko at the December Council Meeting that was sent to him from our **Grand Knight Pablo Martinez** and here are some excerpts from that letter, we also pray for Pablo's full recovery as it is important to give the council an update regarding Pablo as we look to his return and leadership:

Dear Brothers, Vivat Jesus!

I would like to inform our Council about my leave of absence as Grand Knight...you might be aware last year I went through surgery...my recovery is doing well, I am feeling stronger physically, mentally and spiritually...I have followed three key points...have a good attitude...trust your doctors...have faith in God...

Matthew 8:23-26 Jesus Calms a Storm, "He got into a boat and his disciples followed him. Suddenly a violent storm came up on the sea, so that the boat was being swamped by waves; but he was asleep. They came and woke him, saying, "Lord, save us! We are perishing!" He said to them, "Why are you terrified, O you of little faith?" The he got up, rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was great calm.

...These storms come and go, they are part of our humanity, and o one is to blame for them to happen; but if we confront them with good attitude, listen and follow good and reliable advises, and most important having Faith and acknowledgement that Jesus has never abandoned us, we will be able to navigate through these storms and become better people.

I conclude my report saying that I can't wait to return to the Council and continue the mission of the Knights of Columbus. For now, I will focus in my full recovery knowing the Council is in great hands. Thank you for your prayers. Vivat Jesus!
